



AIR HANGAT VILLAGE



This is truly a unique hot spring as it is salt water, not fresh water and this kind of natural salt water hot spring can be found in only three other countries in the world. The main attraction here is the three-tiered hot spring wells and jacuzzis amidst landscaped gardens, plus foot reflexology and a host of other cultural activities such as Malay dance, batik painting, kickboxing etc. A restaurant on-site serves great Malay-Asian cuisine.

ATMA ALAM BATIK ART VILLAGE

Billed as the birthplace of Langkawi's own local handmade batik founded by a Malaysian artist and a batik designer, this cultural centre is a treasure trove of arts and culture with a batik workshop, showroom and art gallery. Offering good quality yet affordable local handicraft products, Atma Alam also provides handson craft opportunities in batik-painting and getting to know the traditional Malaysian batik-making process.



LAKE OF THE PREGNANT <u>MAIDEN</u>

Malay legend has it that princess Mambang Sari and her husband Mat Teja lost their son, so they came to the lake to mourn, where she blessed the waters so that couples having difficulty conceiving should try swimming here. The lovely lake is cloistered on an island of the same name, Dayang Bunting in Malay, south of Langkawi proper and easily reached by boat or even jetski. Besides swimming, there's kayaking and boating, a foot-dipping fish pond and a lakeside jungle boardwalk down to the 'Miracle Border', a thin strip of rocky land that miraculously separates seawater from the freshwater lake.

FAIZY CRYSTAL GLASS BLOWING STUDIO



Langkawi is home to one of the best handcrafted glass artwork studios in Southeast Asia. Established in 2002, the studio's local artists under Mr. Faizy's direction create stunningly delicate and colourful crystal products entirely by hand. Watch the process where air is blown into a molten piece of glass to create a bubble that craftsmen mould into imaginative shapes in a time-consuming process at a furnace so hot of up to 1,400°C. But each beautiful one-off art piece in the showroom is worth all the effort

LANGKAWI CRAFT<u>COMPLEX</u>

LANGKAWI CROCODILE FARM


A popular place of interest in Langkawi, Kompleks Kraf is a one-stop centre that offers a variety of authentic craft products such as batik and hand-woven textiles, carvings, metallic crafts and much more. There are also many interesting activities including craft demonstrations, educational workshops, cultural performances and guided tours. Its attractive architecture and landscaping also make Langkawi Craft Complex a must-go destination.





Learn all about tropical crocodiles in Malaysia's largest crocodile farm. Sprawling over 10 acres in a specially designed and beautifully landscaped zoological recreation park, Taman Buaya Langkawi hosts almost 1000 crocs of various species in dedicated ponds that mimic their natural environment. Visitors also get to witness live shows, crocodile feeding and at the research and development centre even the process of egg collection, incubation, rearing of hatchlings, animal husbandry and conservation measures.

EAGLE SQUARE



Probably Langkawi's single most recognisable symbol and a mustvisit, Dataran Lang is the iconic landmark on the Kuah town waterfront visible from ferries plying in and out of the harbour. Reflecting the island's name from the old Malay 'lang' for eagle and 'kawi' for reddish brown, the large 12m high sculpture of a reddish brown eagle about-tofly dominates the surroundings of landscaped ponds, fountains, shops and pavilions, and even beyond. The bare floor may get a bit hot at the height of day so come in the cool breezy morning or evening, while at night the eagle and its environs are gorgeously lit up.



CHOGM PARK

In October 1989 a working retreat for the 'Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting' was held in Langkawi and this park commemorates the event. Delegates from all participating countries planted trees in the park and each is marked in this now lush, tree-filled garden with a man-made beach for great sunset views. Conveniently located in Kuah town beside Al-Hana Mosque, the Langkawi Fair Mall is also within walking distance for facilities and eateries.

LANGKAWI NATURE PARK (KILIM GEOFOREST PARK)

A marvelous nature park within a bigger geoforest; that's Langkawi Nature Park, a strategic enclave of Kilim Geoforest Park that in turn is within Langkawi Geopark and one of the best ecotourism spots in Southeast Asia. Enjoy boat rides to view the geoforest environment and experience walking on an 800m-long boardwalk through a natural dense mangrove jungle. Several species of birds fly freely in the aviary, and some of the birds and mammals will be led out for a close encounter with visitors during the animal show at a specially designed arena.

FIELD OF BURNT RICE

This historic field marks the site of a true event in 1821. Mass rice burning was conducted by Padang Matsirat's villagers who scorched their rice paddy in an effort to stop them from falling into the hands of Siamese invaders who took over the island. Take time to reflect on the sacrifice of the locals and see the conserved area where the 'Beras Terbakar' or 'burnt rice' happened. Apparently, heavy rain sometimes raises evidence of burnt grains to the surface. Souvenir stalls and surrounding village paddy field views add to the attraction.

GALERIA PERDANA

An interesting gallery housed in attractive Malay-modern hybrid architecture, this museum showcases over 2,500 presents, awards and significant items received over 20 years by Malaysia's Prime Minster Tun Dr. Mahathir Mohamad and his family. The displays cover an astoundingly diverse collection of every imaginable gift from world governments, corporations and others; some of extremely high value so it is great to actually see rather than just read about these objects. It's also great that they're for public view rather than stored out of sight.



LAGENDA PARK

Known in Malay as Taman Lagenda or literally 'Park of Legends', this thoughtfully themed parkland covering 20 hectares showcases Langkawi's legends, myths and folklore from prehistory to historic events of more modern times. Established in 1996 next to Eagle Square in Kuah, the park lets visitors enjoy landscaped gardens while learning about various stories that are

intertwined with many of Langkawi's other attractions. such as the battle between two giants over a wedding argument who later turned into mounts Mat Chinchang and Gunung Raya, and the beautiful Mahsuri who was falsely charged with adultery and executed in the 1800s, or the story of the great birds, the ogres and more -17 stories in all.



ORIENTAL VILLAGE

Lifestyle, especially tropical and oriental, is what this attractive village is all about. The whole village setting is laid out as a lifestyle themed neighbourhood in mixed Malay-Sino-Japanese architecture, centred around a large landscaped lake amidst a green hilly backdrop. A good variety of specialty shops, stalls and eateries vie for your attention with surprisingly diverse offerings from unique souvenirs to universal cuisines, and even a cute hotel. Oriental Village is also the starting point for the Langkawi Cable Car, amphibious Duck Tour plus animal attractions and much more, so it's worth allocating a day for the entire village complex.



BUFFALO PARK LANGKAWI

Kerbau or 'water buffalo' were once commor in Malaysian villages, used as ploughing animals in rice fields. With mechanisation they are now rare, which makes Buffalo Park very valuable in not just preserving local buffalo species but also in continuing a traditional socio-historic legacy. If you love nature and learning about animal husbandry amidst green mountain backdrops, wide fields and of course, buffaloes, then don't miss coming here. It was opened in 2006 when local farmers pooled their paddy lands to create this dairy farm, where today over 100 buffaloes produce all kinds of products from milk to Mozzarella cheese, yoghurt, ice cream, meat and organic fertiliser. There are also buffalo rides and tasty buffalo steak in the on-site restaurant.



RICE MUSEUM (LAMAN PADI)

"Padi" is the Malay word that gives the English 'rice paddy' and "laman" is garden or compound, so 'Laman Padi' is like a rice garden complete with buffaloes that serve as a great backdrop for this rice museum. Almost everything here, outdoor and indoor, is very educational and it's best to use the available guides to explain all that you see. This includes the various fields of rice in different growing stages and the excellent museum of the history and process of rice cultivation. You can even request to try your hand at rice planting. There's also a herbal garden with spa and nice restaurants.



LANGKAWI <u>WILDLIFE</u> PARK

This pleasant family-activity destination first opened in 2002 as Langkawi Bird Paradise with many avian species. Over the vears many more other animal types were added especially mammals and reptiles, and it was renamed Langkawi Wildlife Park in 2006. Now there are colourful birds, cute mammals, scary reptiles and even exotic orchids. While many of the animals are of the 'less-dangerous' kind, they are nonetheless amazing and from all over the world with much 'close encounter', photo-taking and even feeding opportunities, plus there are excellent guides; all of which make the place perfect for kids. It is also fully covered, thus rain or shine you can enjoy an entire visit. Note the schedule to experience specific events and feeding times.



MAKAM MAHSURI (MAHSURI'S TOMB & CULTURAL CENTRE)

Much of modern Langkawi is tied to the legend of Mahsuri, the beautiful maiden who lived on the island about 200 years ago. She was falsely charged with adultery and upon her execution she bled white blood, a sign of innocence, and cursed the island for seven generations. The Siamese invaded soon after and Langkawi wilted. Indeed it was only in the 1980s after seven generations that the islands prospered again as it does today. This multi-faceted cultural centre revolves around Mahsuri's tomb site, with traditional Malay houses, a museum complex telling the story and much more.



MORAC ADVENTURE PARK (GO-KARTING)

As Malaysia's premier international karting centre, this is where you get your adrenaline rush on the 1.5km world standard karting track. Drivers' lap times are precisely recorded and sent straight to participants' smartphones to compare your rank against other drivers. The Park is professionally operated and conforms to the sport's global safety standards. If your lap timing is truly exceptional, you may even compete for a chance to race at the Sodi world series. Hot Laps, the appropriately named restaurant on-site offers local and international dishes plus a full service bar to quench those racing thirsts.



LANGKAWI CABLE CAR

One of the most thrilling and unforgettable cable car rides, and indeed the steepest, in the world is right here. The ride up mount Machinchang from Oriental Village takes you to a height of 708m in almost 15 minutes and gives breathtaking views of the mountains, valleys, the Andaman Sea and islands all


the way to Thailand on a clear day. There are viewing platforms and pleasant side activities at the top but the grand highlight is Langkawi Skybridge, a spectacular curved single-pylon suspension bridge and one of the greatest feats of engineering.

ROYAL LANGKAWI YACHT CLUB

For yacht and premium boat owners the Royal Langkawi Yacht Club is no stranger, being Malaysia's only award-winning marina with the best facilities and luxuries. Located on the ocean-side southeast corner of Langkawi, the 250-berth marina accommodates up to 90m-long megayachts. Kuah town centre is just 2km or


a few minutes drive away for convenient access to duty-free shops, banks and other urban amenities. There's also the excellent Royal Langkawi Yacht Club Hotel as well as Fisherman's Wharf alongside. The famous Royal Langkawi International Regatta has its home base here.





While Kedah shares staple food ingredients such as rice and noodles with the region, there are recipes so original to the state until it bears its name. Laksa Kedah is one such must-try, a fish-based soupy rice noodle dish. For a local cuppa, try our local coffees such as 'kopi Kedah' and 'kopi Cap Gantang' and you won't go wrong.







Essential Information

We trust that everything goes well in your visit to Kedah. But just in case, here are essential contacts and other useful information that would help in ensuring that your stay is on track





If ancient traders could travel to Kedah since nearly 2000 years ago, you can too. Located on the northwest coast of Peninsular Malaysia, it is one of the country's northern gateways bordering Thailand to its north. You can travel to Kedah by air, road, rail or sea even on a cruise ship.

Getting to the Kedah Mainland

BY AIR

Malaysia Airlines, AirAsia, Malindo Air and others operate daily air services direct from Kuala Lumpur to Kedah. You can take flights from Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) or Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport (Subang Skypark) to Sultan Abdul Halim Airport in Kepala Batas just 20 minutes' drive from Alor Setar, or to Langkawi Airport.

BY ROAD

Just a five-hour drive from Kuala Lumpur brings you to Kedah using the North-South Expressway (PLUS). Air-conditioned express buses to Kedah can be taken at KL's Terminal Bersepadu Selatan or Hentian Duta bus hubs. Bus services go to Alor Setar, Sungai Petani, Gurun, Jitra, Kulim, Baling and Bukit Kayu Hitam at the Thai border. Buses, taxis and even e-hailing car services are also available from neighbouring states to Kedah and vice versa.

BY RAIL

Fast and comfortable KTM Electric Train Services (ETS) express trains run from KL Sentral station in Kuala Lumpur daily and stop at major towns in Kedah including Alor Setar, Sungai Petani, Gurun and Anak Bukit before proceeding to neighbouring Perlis. Visitors heading for Langkawi should disembark at Alor Setar or Arau in Perlis and proceed to the respective ietty terminals to arrange their transfer. The border town of Bukit Kayu Hitam is the entry point for visitors who are arriving from Sadao, Thailand, There is an Immigration and Customs checkpoint at the border crossing that is open for travellers from 6.00am to midnight (Malaysian time).

GETTING AROUND

SELF-DRIVE

Rent a car at the airport or via car rental services and explore Kedah on the comprehensive network of roads around the state.

BUSES AND TAXIS

There are transport terminals in each city and major town in Kedah for local buses, interstate buses and taxis with a major hub in Alor Setar known as Terminal Shahab Perdana at Jalan Langgar. In Sungai Petani, the main bus terminal is situated at Ukir Square, Jalan Kuala Ketil. Get to various towns in Kedah and other major destinations in Peninsular Malaysia especially Kuala Lumpur, Penang, Melaka, Kuantan and Johor Bahru by bus. For festive and holiday seasons tickets must be booked in advance.

GETTING TO LANGKAWI

BY AIR

Malaysia Airlines operates daily air services to Langkawi from Kuala Lumpur, while its subsidiary, Firefly, offers daily flights to Langkawi from the Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport in Subang and Penang. AirAsia provides daily flights to Langkawi from Kuala Lumpur and other cities. There are direct flights to Langkawi even from Singapore.

BY SEA

Express ferries provide regular services to Langkawi from Kuala Kedah in mainland Kedah and Kuala Perlis in the neighbouring state of Perlis. The sea ride from Kuala Kedah takes about 1 hour 15 minutes. Ferry services to Langkawi are also available from Penang as well as Satun, Thailand.

BY RAIL

Travellers heading for Langkawi may refer to the section above and disembark at Alor Setar or also Arau in Perlis and proceed to the respective jetty terminal at Kuala Kedah or Kuala Perlis for ferries to the island.

- Handshakes are generally acceptable for both men and women, but observant Muslim ladies or even men may acknowledge introductions to the opposite gender simply by nodding and smiling. A Malaysian welcome greeting is the right palm placed over the heart with a slight nod and the reply is the same. The more traditional greeting or salam resembles a handshake but uses both hands without the grasp. After the hands touch, they are lightly brought to the chest to mean the greeting is heartfelt.
- Footwear must always be removed when visiting homes or places of worship such as mosques and temples. Most mosques provide robes and scarves for ladies, and sarongs for men wearing shorts. When sitting on the floor, men sit cross-legged while women normally sit with their legs tucked to either side

- To eat and also to give or receive something, the right hand is always used (unless it is a large item where both hands are needed).
- When pointing, it is preferable to use the right hand's thumb with the other four fingers folded under, rather than the forefinger especially when pointing to a person. Always ask for permission before taking photographs of someone or when inside someone's home.
- The country's Muslim majority (about two-thirds of the population) does not consume pork or any porcine products nor liquor or alcoholic beverages. Thus, toasting is not a common practice.
- The weather is generally quite warm with occasional torrential showers. Cotton or light clothes, rubber shoes and hats are suitable. Note that some establishments such as upmarket restaurants may not allow slippers, shorts or sleeveless.



Malaysia at a Glance

COUNTRY

The federation of Malaysia comprises Peninsular Malaysia (which is made up of 11 states), the large states of Sabah and Sarawak on Borneo Island and three Federal Territories namely Kuala Lumpur the capital, Putrajaya the federal administrative city and Labuan offshore financial centre.

CAPITAL CITY

Kuala Lumpur is the capital where the Parliament and the King's palace are, while Putrajaya is the federal administrative centre.

GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION

Lying 2 to 7 degrees north of the Equator, Peninsular Malaysia is separated from Sabah and Sarawak by Laut Bunguran or the South China Sea. The Peninsular is bordered with Thailand in the north, while its southern neighbour is Singapore. The states of Sabah and Sarawak on Borneo Island share a common border with Indonesia while Sarawak also shares a border with Brunei Darussalam.

329,758 sq km

POPULATION

32.5 million

PEOPLE

Malay and related Bumiputra groups make up about 65% of the population, with Chinese, Indians and other ethnic groups making up the rest.

LANGUAGE

Bahasa Melayu (*Malay language*) is the national language but English is widely spoken. Malaysians also speak various ethnic languages and dialects.

RELIGION

Islam is the official religion but all major religions are practiced freely and visitors will see mosques, churches and Buddhist, Taoist, Hindu or Sikh temples all over the country.

GOVERNMENT

Malaysia practices parliamentary democracy and constitutional monarchy. The Head of State is the Yang di-Pertuan Agong (the King or 'Agong' for short) and the Head of Government is the Prime Minister. The country has a bicameral legislative system, with general and state elections required every five years.

CLIMATE

Malaysia has a tropical climate and the weather is warm and humid all year round. Daily temperature range is from 21°C in early morning to 32°C or more in urban area afternoons. The average annual rainfall varies from 2.000mm to 2.500mm.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Visitors must be in possession of a valid passport or acknowledged travel document with a minimum validity of six months beyond the intended stay period. Citizens of most countries do not require visas for social or business meeting visits. For further information, please call or visit the nearest Malaysian diplomatic mission or Tourism Malaysia office.

CURRENCY

The monetary currency unit is the Malaysian Ringgit, which is domestically denoted as RM and in international banking as MYR. Foreign currencies can be freely changed at banks and money changers.

TIME

Standard Malaysia time is eight hours ahead of GMT and 16 hours ahead of US Pacific Standard Time.

WORKING DAYS

Government and most offices in all states, with the exception of Kedah, Kelantan and Terengganu, operate on a five-day week from Monday to Friday. Government offices in Kedah, Kelantan and Terengganu are open from Sunday to Thursday. They are closed on Friday and Saturday.

BANKING HOURS

In most states, banking hours are from 9.30am to 4.00pm from Monday to Friday. Banks in the states of Kelantan and Terengganu operate from 9.30am to 4.00pm from Saturday to Thursday.

POST OFFICES

Most post offices are open from 8.00am to 5.00pm daily except on state weekends and public holidays.

ELECTRICITY

The voltage used throughout Malaysia is 220–240 volts AC, at 50 cycles per second. Standard 3-pin sockets and square plugs are used.

MEASUREMENT SYSTEM

Malaysia uses the international metric system.

TELECOMMUNICATIONS

Malaysia is openly linked nationally and internationally by telephone, facsimile, telegraph and via the internet. Most hotels provide International Direct Dial (IDD) telephone services as well as Internet Wi-Fi connection.

GETTING TO MALAYSIA

The most popular gateway to Malaysia is through the Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) at Sepang, located just over 50km south of Kuala Lumpur. Other major international airports that serve as entry points are at Penang, Johor Bahru, Kuching, Kota Kinabalu and the island of Langkawi as well as a smaller airport at Subang near Kuala Lumpur. Around 50 international airlines fly into the country. The national carrier, Malaysia Airlines, is complemented by budget airlines or other operators such as AirAsia, Malindo Air and Firefly.

The main entry point by sea is at Port Klang about 30km west of Kuala Lumpur, especially for cruise ships with other ports of call in Penang and Langkawi islands.

Peninsular Malaysia is also accessible by rail and road from Singapore and Thailand.

GETTING AROUND

Malaysia has excellent domestic air links services by Malaysia Airlines and low-cost carriers such as AirAsia, Malindo Air and Firefly. The country has a relatively well-developed and efficient public transportation system served by buses and taxis, as well as trains on the Peninsula. E-hailing vehicle services are also available.

ACCOMMODATION

Malaysia has a wide range of accommodation at very competitive rates. International star-rated hotels, beach or forest resorts, chalets, budget hotels, hostels, serviced apartments and registered homestays or kampungstays are just some of the many types of accommodation available. Online booking is popular.


