





## Initiatives & Improvement by BSMKP

Implementation of performance management system that is based on the department's functions known as MyPerformance for officers from management and professional (P&P) as well as support groups effective from 1st January 2024. The MyPerformance function has been available but yet to be activated in the HRMIS system for all permanent officers, and will also be replacing Yearly Performance Evaluation Report (LNPT). Starting from 2022 until 2023, JPA had required all government agencies including LADA to implement familiarisation with this system.

Improvement of Human Resource Training Policy via the creation of Human Resource Development Policy (DPSM) by JPA (January 2022). The policy released in January 2022 aims to develop competency of public officers in fulfilling current needs, as well as being prepared in facing future challenges.

Therefore, BSMKP will be developing internal guidelines related to high-performance human resource development. Starting from this year too, each officer and staff is required to complete 40 hours of trainings and courses, compared to attending four days of courses in the previous years.

In LADA too, BSMKP is currently at the final stage of revising the agency's Prudent Spending, COVID-19 Control Guidelines, and Medical AKPEs. The revision takes into consideration of several matters as forwarded in LADA's Inter-Department Council (MBJ).

LADA's Top Management has also decided on the candidates for BSMKP's Manager and Deputy Manager who will be reporting for duty around March ahead. With this, BSMKP and Asset Management Division (BPA) will once again be merged under one management. This merging is therefore hoped to be able to further fortify high-performance human resource management and solidify the integrated organisational administration as well as asset management in LADA.

- Initiated the transformation of digital record management in LADA effective from 6th January 2021, making LADA among the first government agencies in Langkawi, in fact Kedah to begin utilising Digital Document Management System (DDMS) in management of department's records.
